A Berlin flame mahogany armoire display cabinet having a stepped pediment inlaid with boxwood stringing above partially glazed doors divided into four sections with scroll marquetry escutcheons.

Neo-classicism is often characterised as cold or hard, but in this case, the clean architectural lines and dramatic flame veneer mahogany are softened by boxwood stringing, the playful marquetry escutcheons, and the cheerful painted interior.
